Camdenton Police Department strives to maintain a safe community for our citizens and provide the services that our citizens desire. We dedicate considerable time to prevention and problem solving in addition to enforcement as part of the Community Policing philosophy. Here are some highlights:

#### **Alcohol & Drug Enforcement:**

- *Officer Kempen* touches the lives of 1,338 students (99-00) while teaching DARE and VEGA.
- Officers enforce DWI's, making 66 arrests, conducting 1 sobriety checkpoint and 5 saturated patrols.
- Officers fight against drugs, making 96 arrests; *Officer C. Rector* responsible for nearly 30% of those.
- *Sgt. Beauchamp* dedicated 300 hours with *Nitro* and answered 109 calls throughout the lake area.
- TIPS line installed to offer citizens with method to provide information anonymously (317-1800).

#### **Community Interaction:**

- Officers conducted approximately 31 meetings with various groups, contacting over 2,000 people
- *Officer Kempen* added several features to our web page, which received 3,650 hits during the year.
- Officers raised \$2,082 for Missouri Special Olympics through T-shirt sales and Polar Bear Plunge.
- *Sgt. Beauchamp, Officer Ross, Williams and Wright* participated in the lake area law enforcement benefit football game for Concerns of Police Survivors, which raised approximately \$5,000.
- *Sgt. Patrickus* continues serving on the executive board of Citizens Against Domestic Violence.

#### **Employee Recognition:**

- *Sgt. Beauchamp and Officer Rensing* were commended for their quick action on a burglary when the suspect was tracked from the business and arrested within minutes.
- *Officer Williams* was commended for his tenacity when he took some sketchy drug information and netted over 35 grams of marijuana and fourteen arrests.
- *Officers C. Rector* was commended for thoroughness when a traffic stop for erratic driving netted seizure of 225 grams of marijuana and felony charges.

#### **Equipment:**

- Added a 2000 Jeep Cherokee to our fleet to increase our capabilities during inclement weather.
- Received a laptop computer for the Community Policing through a grant by Mo Dept. of Public Safety.

#### **School Resource Officers:**

- *School Resource Officers Williams & Wright* met with several classes on issues such as Search & Seizure, Violence in Schools, Child Abuse, Bus Safety, ect.
- SRO Officers "job shadowed" several students about careers in law enforcement.
- SRO Officers worked with school officials to continue improvement of the safety response plan.
- SRO Officers formulated and implemented a new parking plan for the entire campus.

#### **Traffic Safety & Criminal Investigations:**

- Accidents increased slightly in 2000; number of injury accidents decreased from 18.2% to 14.7%.
- Officers conducted two Aggressive Driving campaigns using signboards & speed monitor trailer.
- Officers dedicated 47 hours overtime targeting seat belt and child safety seats (Make It Click Grant).
- Police began enforcing the handicap parking and fire lanes ordinance on private property.
