Hours – 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

-Paper recycling only at this location to include hard/paperback books, junk mail, paper labels from cans, magazines and catalogues, newspapers including slick inserts, office paper, construction paper, shredded paper (empty from bag), paper cartons for eggs & fruit, flattened pasteboard without plastic or wax coating, pasteboard inserts from kitchen papers/paper towel/toilet paper rolls, phone directories, wrapping/brown papers, cleaned feed/seed bags with rip strings – all items must be dried and clean

No cost to city residents (must show proof of in-city residency)

-Plastics (Container 1-soda bottles, water bottles, milk jugs; Container 2-bleach bottles, laundry detergent bottles, juice bottles, grocery bags, plastic food storage containers, etc)

-Tin Cans (Container 3 – corn, pea, green bean, soup, tomato, cans, etc)

-Rinse & sort all containers prior to recycling
